# WE ARE SHAMAR NATION

A prayer group specifically orchestrated by the Holy Spirit for intercession. It is imperative that in this season, we take our proper position as a prayer warrior. That position is being on our post and in place on the wall. We are watchmen on the wall and through Prophetic Intercession, we have an advantage, it is called the vantage point - a position that affords a great advantageous perspective. As an intercessor, it is our job to always be alert, on guard, and on the wall.

Ezekiel 33:1-7 says, 1. Again the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, 2. Son of man, speak to the children of thy people, and say unto them, When I bring the sword upon a land, if the people of the land take a man of their coasts, and set him for their watchman: 3. If when he seeth the sword come upon the land, he blow the trumpet, and warn the people; 4. Then whosoever heareth the sound of the trumpet, and taketh not warning; if the sword come, and take him away, his blood shall be upon his own head. 5. He heard the sound of the trumpet, and took not warning; his blood shall be upon him. But he that taketh warning shall deliver his soul. 6. But if the watchman see the sword come, and blow not the trumpet, and the people be not warned; if the sword come, and take any person from among them, he is taken away in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at the watchman's hand. 7. *So thou, O son of man, I have set thee a watchman unto the house of Israel; therefore thou shalt hear the word at my mouth, and warn them from me.*

# Prayer Watch

In Colossians 4:2 Paul says that you are to pray fervently. You are to be consistent in prayer. Yet, he adds that you are to do this with vigilance. This word is translated a variety of ways, but its basic meaning is to be watchful. Paul combines this with the command to pray fervently. He is saying that you are to pray fervently with a watchful spirit. What are you supposed to be watching? You are to watch what is going on around you. You are to look for the distinct ways that you can pray for your community or city and your neighbors. It is watching and observing what is going on around you that you might pray fervently and consistently concerning these matters. When we are strategic we can go beyond just praying the scriptures to praying by revelation.

Spiritual mapping is observing what is going on around you that you might pray. It is paying attention to peoples' lives and the situation of your city or community that you might pray and exercise spiritual influence.

# Prayer Watch

There are eight prayer watches described in the Bible. Everyone is given a watch. At different times and seasons in your life, you may find that your prayer watch time changes. Every watch has a purpose.

The Lord instructed us to watch and pray (Mark 14:38). We must be WATCHING! We have entered a time when we need the watchmen anointing to function in order to escape calamity and disaster.

"I have set watchmen on your walls, O Jerusalem; they shall never hold their peace day or night. You who make mention of the LORD, do not keep silent, and give Him no rest till He establishes and till He makes Jerusalem a praise in the earth." Isaiah 62:6-7 (NKJV)

# Watch

To WATCH means: to look out; to peer into the distance; to investigate or get a new scope on something; to see an approaching danger and WARN those endangered. The Bible says: (2 Kings 9:17-18)

Women were called to watch after their household (Proverbs 31:27) which means to SEE so you can GUARD your FUTURE.

I see the Lord restoring the actual WATCHES of the night so we can see things we have never seen before. God is reordering our day so that we enter into His timeframe and experience the power of seeing what He sees.

Several words linked with watching are: shaqad (to "be alert") - to be wakeful, so you can see either for good or evil (Jeremiah 31:28; 51:12, Isaiah 29:20); shamar (to "protect") - may mean a day or night watch; thus, there was a guard of the king's house (2 Kings 11:5-7, Nehemiah 4:9; 7:3); gregoreo (to "keep awake, to watch") - to take heed, lest through remissiveness and indolence one be led to forsake Christ (Matthew 26:41; Mark 14:38); nepho (to "abstain from wine, be sober") - used in the NT figuratively, to be calm and collected in spirit; to be temperate, dispassionate, circumspect (1 Thessalonians 5:6; 2 Timothy 4:5).

# Awaken!

In the Bible, we find a pattern. Watchman on the wall are watching for the enemy and announcing what they see. Matthew 24:43 says, "But know this, that if the good man of the house had known in what watch the thief would come, he would have watched, and would not have suffered his house to be broken up." I believe these words of Jesus are some of the most important words for us to understand today.

If we would watch then we would understand the time of visitation of the Lord. We would also recognize the thief when he comes. If we would watch then we would not have to suffer and be scattered in directions. We would remain whole. This verse has a dispensational connotation but also has a reality for today.

# Understanding the Eight Prayer Watches:

## First Prayer Watch

### (6:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M.)

The first prayer watch begins in the evening, which is the “foundation” of night. The evening is a time for us to relax and be with family. It is also a time when we reflect upon what occurred during the day (good or bad) and pray a prayer of thanksgiving to God for being with us and bringing us through it (1 Chronicles 23:30)

6 p.m. to 9 p.m. – Time of meditation (having the Word manifest inside of us); time for divine judgments; time for deliverance; time for resurrection; time to pray for the economy; down the walls of darkness; shake out all the wicked structures from our economic systems, educational systems, religious systems, political systems and all other systems.

The first watch is linked with the call of God upon the life of Israel. This is synonymous to the call of God on our lives. If we will enter into the watch, then we can see His time of visitation. There is a time of visitation for each one of us. Every nation has a time of visitation. Of course, this verse refers to the nation of Israel but is applicable to each one of us as well.

Micah 7:4-7 “4 Even the best and most honest of them are as worthless as weeds.

The day has come when God will punish the people, as he warned them through their watchmen, the prophets. Now they are in confusion.

5 Don't believe your neighbor or trust your friend. Be careful what you say even to your husband or wife. 6 (A) In these times sons treat their fathers like fools, daughters oppose their mothers, and young women quarrel with their mothers-in-law; your enemies are the members of your own family.

7 But I will watch for the Lord; I will wait confidently for God, who will save me. My God will hear me.”

**\*\*These verses repeat the idea that one should not trust in his own protection, because God is the only source of protection, safety, and peace. Even the most intimate human relationships snap under strain, and each one looks out for oneself, as is happening to these people.**

# Understanding the Eight Prayer Watches:

## Second Prayer Watch (9:00 P.M. to 12:00 A.M.)

The second prayer watch is the time in which intercessors are able to impact the spiritual realm before the enemy gets ready to wreak havoc. In the natural, this watch is characterized by deep darkness. In the spiritual realm, this is the time when diabolical assignments and sabotage from the enemy are set in motion.

### Pray for God's Intervention

During this watch, it is important for intercessors to pray for God's protection over their families, cities, and nations: "Let God arise and His enemies be scattered" (Psalm 68:1).

9 p.m. to midnight – Time for thanksgiving; time for visitation; the time when the Lord prepares you to receive many acts of change in the earth. Midnight is symbolic of intense darkness but God is the light in the darkness and releases strategy during this time.

The second watch comes when we get scattered. As we can see from the verse above, if we do not watch, then we get scattered. If you never develop a personal discipline of watching, then you will find your life scattered, instead of being ordered. The second watch also represents times of Israel's scattering.

# Understanding the Eight Prayer Watches:

## Third Prayer Watch

### (12:00 A.M. to 3:00 A.M.)

Midnight to 3 a.m. – Time for prayers of protection and strength to overcome; time for outpouring of the spirit of grace; to overcome every limitation of gifts and anointing; special time for divine governments; overruling human decrees to give an angelic release.

Midnight Watch - The Third Watch of the Night - A time for Warfare Prayers

Satanic plots can be escaped and the judgment of the Lord can be released

- The third **prayer** watch is a period of much spiritual activity. This watch hour will strengthen your faith. It is the same time that Peter denied Christ three times. ([Matthew 26:34,74](#); [Mark 14:30](#); [Luke 22:34](#) ; [John 13:38](#) ). him ([1 Kings 3:20](#)). This watch calls for seasoned intercessors.

Midnight to 3 a.m. – Time for prayers of protection and strength to overcome; time for outpouring of the spirit of grace; to overcome every limitation of gifts and anointing; special time for divine governments; overruling human decrees to give an angelic release.

Midnight Watch - The Third Watch of the Night - A time for Warfare Prayers

Satanic plots can be escaped and the judgment of the Lord can be released

Psalm 119:61-62

The cords of the wicked have bound me, But I have not forgotten Your law.

At midnight I will rise to give thanks to You, Because of Your righteous judgments.

# The Witching Hour

## Third Prayer Watch

### (12:00 A.M. to 3:00 A.M.)

- ▶ This watch is the darkest and most demonic part of the night, especially at midnight. Witches, warlocks, and Satanists have fun and start their incantations during this part of the night. The devil operates at this time because this is the time that men are in a deep sleep and there are not as many people praying to oppose.
- ▶ You must not be afraid of witchcraft during this watch. The Lord has given us dominion and authority over all things. This watch is geared for those who already know how to use their spiritual armor and war against the enemy. This is the time to pray against satanic attacks on your life, family members, marriages, churches, and communities. We are most vulnerable to the devil's attacks because at this time we are asleep. Declare Psalm 91:5-6 for Divine protection for yourself, family, church, city and nation.

# The Witching Hour

## Third Prayer Watch

### (12:00 A.M. to 3:00 A.M.)

- ▶ This watch is the darkest and most demonic part of the night, especially at midnight. Witches, warlocks, and satanists have fun and start their incantations during this part of the night. The devil operates at this time because this is the time that men are in a deep sleep and there are not as many people praying to oppose.
- ▶ You must not be afraid of witchcraft during this watch. The Lord has given us dominion and authority over all things. # Third Prayer Watch (12:00 A.M. to 3:00 A.M.)

- ▶ A wicked plot is revealed and the plan of aversion is executed at the Midnight Watch - Acts 23:19-31
- ▶ A time to set prisoners free and command salvation from bondages - Acts 16:25-29
- ▶ Plots are revealed and plans to escape are executed - Acts 27:25-44 - Read the whole story but here's the part I want you to focus on: Verses 27-31
- ▶ Release the Angel of Covenant to execute the Judgment of Elohim - Exodus 12:29

# Third Prayer Watch (12:00 A.M. to 3:00 A.M.) What to Pray Against

- ▶ It is a time to pray against all sexual immorality such as fornication, adultery, prostitution, orgies, occult sexual activities, homosexuality, sexual abuse and rape. This is the time to awake out of sleep and confront every storm that has been coming against your life that you may have rest and peace in God.
- ▶ It is during this watch that the destroying angel goes through communities, cities, nations and the world to bring death. It is time for dreams and visions and it is also time for miracles to be performed as well as covenants to be remembered.

# Third Prayer Watch (12:00 A.M. to 3:00 A.M.)

## During The Midnight Watch Pray For:

- ▶ **1. Divine Protection**
- ▶ Psalm 91:5 You shall not be afraid of the terror by night, Nor of the arrow that flies by day,
- ▶ Isaiah 17:14 Then behold, at eventide, trouble! And before the morning, he is no more.
- ▶ This is the portion of those who plunder us, And the lot of those who rob us.
- ▶ **2. Release from Demonic Strongholds & Prisons**
- ▶ Acts 16:25-34 (where the jailer and his whole house are saved after Paul and Silas and all the prisoners are miraculously set free)
- ▶ **A time to possess our gates and destroy the plans of the enemy**
  - ▶ Judges 16:3 Now Samson went to Gaza and saw a harlot there, and went in to her. <sup>2</sup>When the Gazites were told, “Samson has come here!” they surrounded the place and lay in wait for him all night at the gate of the city. They were quiet all night, saying, “In the morning, when it is daylight, we will kill him.” <sup>3</sup>And Samson lay low till midnight; then he arose at midnight, took hold of the doors of the gate of the city and the two gateposts, pulled them up, bar and all, put them on his shoulders, and carried them to the top of the hill that faces Hebron.

# Third Prayer Watch (12:00 A.M. to 3:00 A.M.)

## During The Midnight Watch Pray For:

- ▶ **Angelic Intervention - Deploy The Angel of the Lord - 2 Kings 19:32-35**
- ▶ **Pray for Marriages - Pray for an open door for marriages see Matthew 25:6 -10**
- ▶ **Virtuous Women should pray to be found by their Boaz and that he will close the deal. see Ruth 3:7-1**
- ▶ **Peace & Calm - Matthew 8:23-27**
- ▶ **Alertness & Concentration - Matthew 13:25**
- ▶ **Time to Watch & Pray - Mark 1:35**
- ▶ **Every Need & Provision to Be Met - Genesis 32:24-30**
- ▶ **Deploy The Blood of Jesus against the spirit of premature death, destruction and wickedness against our children - Exodus 12:13**
- ▶ **Protection for the City - 2 Kings 19:32-35**

# Third Prayer Watch (12:00 A.M. to 3:00 A.M.) During The Midnight Watch Pray For:

- ▶ **Pray Against Sexual Sins of Homosexuality & Rape**
- ▶ **Read Judges 19-21** if you are dealing with anything related to perversion and the homosexual agenda or a curse of rape and molestation that runs in your family. It is a very lengthy piece on the tribe of Benjamin and their near annihilation and the warfare that went into destroying them. Israel was defeated three times but kept asking the Lord at midnight to keep fighting the enemy of perversion. Its a very profound teaching on spiritual warfare and would take too long for this teaching so remind me and I'll teach it at another time. But, with persistent prayer and a Midnight Cry we can eliminate this perversion from our bloodlines and defeat the agenda of satan. We just can't relax and permit it. If you don't fight, you can't win.
- ▶ **Be Ready To Move Out & Keep Oil in Your Lamps**
- ▶ **Matthew 25:1-13** - This is about Divine preparation. In this Year - The year of His Double - may you be divinely prepared to possess your possessions. If you know there are some doors - great and effectual doors - that must be opened to you - this is your watch to wage WAR!

# Fourth Prayer Watch (3:00 A.M. to 6:00 A.M.)

- ▶ The fourth prayer watch is always important because this is the last watch of the night. This watch is the time that satanic agents, who went out to perform their activities, are returning to their bases. During this time, the Israelites were delivered from slavery in Egypt (Exodus 12,14). This is also the time Jesus walked on the water to help the disciples who were caught in the storm (Matthew 14:25-33). The fourth prayer watch is the time to establish the course of your day by speaking God's Word and breaking everything that would attempt to hinder His will for your life to manifest on third day. (Psalms 19:2).
- ▶ 3 a.m. to 6 a.m. – Time to pray for freedom of the Bride. Angelic activity or intervention; the time when God releases the dew of heaven; time for blessings from heaven above; blessings of the deep that lies beneath; blessings of the womb; blessings of our fathers and ancestors. God has to bless His people.
- ▶ "In I Samuel 11, after Saul had been anointed by Samuel to be the King over Israel, Nahash the Ammonite set up camp to fight the people of Jabesh Gilead and to take them captive along with their resources and land. The Elders of Jabesh Gilead asked Nahash to make treaty with them so that they would not be overtaken. Nahash would only agree to make treaty if all their right eyes could be gouged out.

# Fourth Prayer Watch

## (3:00 A.M. to 6:00 A.M.)

- ▶ "The Morning Watch is the fourth watch. This watch waits for the dawning of the new day. The morning watch is described as beginning at 3:00 AM and ending at 6:00 AM. This watch is linked with the approaching of the morning light and the breaking of the day. We are beginning a new day! There are many enemies aligned against us and the purposes of God for this generation. How we discern and advance is very important and we must see and hear clearly concerning everything that would threaten our perception and perspective of what is before us.
- ▶ The fourth watch comes during the Lord's time of revealing His glory. There is a breaking of a new day. This is where the identity of our future is established. Even with all of Israel's problems throughout history, as a nation, they have a wonderful future. They are God's chosen nation of example. All nations align and reconcile around their relationship with Israel.
- ▶ This watch also represents the power of resurrection as we watch with the Lord. If you will continue to watch with the Lord, then you will experience His glory.

# Fourth Prayer Watch (3:00 A.M. to 6:00 A.M.)

- ▶ The FOURTH, or Morning, Watch is NOW Being Restored!
- ▶ The FOURTH WATCH is linked with the approaching of the morning light and the breaking of the day. There are several words in the Bible linked with this watch! The Lord said if we would arise when He called us, then we would hear and see during the night so we could rule during the day. We are in a war! This war over covenant blessings means that we are entering:
  - ▶ • A time to awaken to latter day blessings and leave our wanderings (Hosea 6:1-3).
  - ▶ • A time for religious rituals to break (John 2:1-10).
  - ▶ • A time for a new reality of His power to overtake His people (John 4).
  - ▶ • A time when our faith is being tested (Psalm 66).
  - ▶ • A time when our vision and provision for our future is being released (Genesis 22).
  - ▶ • A time to MANIFEST a new bold identity (Esther 5).
  - ▶ • A time that the Lord will give us His plan to RESTORE ALL! (Luke 19).
  - ▶ • A time to see God's desire upon His enemies (Psalm 92).
  - ▶ • A time to sound a clear warning of the enemy's plan to take Your inheritance (2 Chronicles 20)!

# Fourth Prayer Watch

## (3:00 A.M. to 6:00 A.M.)

- ▶ We are not just watching on behalf of the Church, but on behalf of a Kingdom that is in conflict and advancing in the earth. I am declaring that as you watch, you will see where and how the thief entered in and stole your blessings. Once you understand what the thief has done, you can call back your loss as a seven-fold increase.
- ▶ Allow the Lord to reorder your day and bring you into a new place of watching with Him! As you order your prayers, He will order your steps and begin to reorder the timeframe of your day. You will then develop His mind for increase and multiplication, and see His restorative plan manifested in your life, family, church, city and nation.
- ▶ Many watches were developed so that protection would be established for God's people. One of the greatest studies on the watch is linked with 2 Kings 11. The fourth watch is the last portion of the night, so we always need to be ready to arise and watch. The word generally refers to the day and means the hour of dawn or soon after (Genesis 19:2, 2 Chronicles 36:15, Hosea 6:4, Luke 24:22). Ask the Lord to meet you early so you are prepared for the day ahead.
- ▶ Here is the Prayer Focus. This will give you faith to pray for your supply, stay steady, and watch the Lord break open the next day that is ready to dawn on His people! Break Open a New Day!

# Fifth Prayer Watch

## (6:00 A.M. to 9:00 A.M.)

- ▶ 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. – This time is for declarations and utterances; equipment of service; transforming of minds; the time that God strengthens Christians.
- ▶ The fifth prayer watch is a time for both spiritual and physical strengthening (Acts 2:15; Psalm 2:7-9). The spiritual significant of sunrise is having Jesus Christ, the King of kings and the Lord of lords, rise over us (Malachi 4:2). During this watch, pray for such issues as healing in your body, relationships, family, government, and the economy.

Time for the Holy Spirit to prepare us (2 Corinthians 9:30; Ephesians 4:12)

Acts 2:15 says it was the “third hour of the day” (or 9:00 A.M.) when the Holy Spirit descended in the Upper Room on the day of Pentecost to equip the 120 disciples for service. Regular work schedules usually begin between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 9:00 A.M. As you step out, ask the Holy Spirit to equip you for the day.

# Fifth Prayer Watch

## (6:00 A.M. to 9:00 A.M.)

### Prayer Decrees for This Watch

Heavenly Father...

- Today I entrust my work to You; and, I know my plans will work out well. I can do everything You ask me to with the help of Christ who gives me the strength and power, in Jesus' Name. (Philippians 4:13; Proverbs 16:3)
- Because I reverence Your Name, Your goodness shines on me like the sun with healing in its rays. (Malachi 4:2)
- I praise You and never forget how kind You are to me! You forgive all my sins and heal all my sicknesses. You save me from the grave and surround me with loving-kindness and tender mercies. (Psalms 103:2-4)
- I release the healing virtue of Jesus Christ into my body. I curse at the root every attack upon my health. Jehovah-Rophe healed me and keeps me in perfect health all the days of my life. I plead the Blood of Jesus against calamities, catastrophes and any hidden dangers that would try to come against me. Through the Blood of Jesus, I have been redeemed out of the hands of the devil.
- I am a channel for Your use because my life is not my own. I dedicate my body as a living sacrifice—holy and well-pleasing to You. (Romans 12:1)

# Sixth Prayer Watch (9:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M.)

9 a.m. to noon – Time for forgiveness; healing of relationships; harvest; scientific and technological advances; exits and entry watch.

The sun is at its brightest during the sixth prayer watch. God's Divine love for us shone bright in the darkest period of human history when Jesus Christ was sentenced and crucified at the third hour, or 9:00 A.M. (Mark 15:25, Matthew 27:45). After having been on the Cross for three hours, darkness came upon the face of the earth at 12:00 P.M. and continued until 3:00 P.M. The human race was in darkness, held by Satan's grip, but Christ's work on the cross redeemed us and restored our relationship with God, the Father.

The Apostle Paul says that we should be thankful to God because, through the sacrifice of Jesus Christ, He "hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins," (Colossians 1:13, KJV ). So, this prayer watch is a time to reflect on the power of the Cross. Because of Christ, we have direct access to God and His benefits and blessings.

- ▶ Time to See God's Promises Fulfilled - (Exodus 12:35-36)
- ▶ Prayer Decrees for This Watch - (Proverbs 16:3), (Philippians 4:13; Proverbs 16:3), (Malachi 4:2), (Psalms 103:2-4)

# Seventh Prayer Watch (12:00 P.M. to 3:00 P.M.)

- ▶ Noon to 3 p.m. – Time that the promises of God are released; shaking of foundations; dwelling in the secret place of the most high; Time to exercise God-given dominion.
- ▶ The seventh prayer watch begins at noon. Midday is an hour of rest and a time to seek the Lord. Historically, Christ was on the cross, during this time, atoning for the sins of the world. God's redemption and restoration for mankind was manifested through His Son. Peter received the vision of the clean and unclean animals which initiated the inclusion of the Gentiles in God's redemptive plan. Also, it was during this watch that Daniel always went home to pray.

- ▶ Time of the Secret Place of the Most High (Psalm 91:1 )

It is very important to pray in line with Acts 10:9 and Psalm 91:5 , 6 , 14 . This is the time to pray to “dwell in the secret place of the Most High, abiding under the shadow of the Almighty,” and making the Most High your habitation. Pray and cut off all satanic arrows that are released at this time so that they will not get you or your family.

# Seventh Prayer Watch (12:00 P.M. to 3:00 P.M.)

**Time of Letting Your Light Shine Brighter until the Full Light of Day is Attained (Prov. 4:18)**

- ▶ The midday is the beginning of the sixth hour (12:00 P.M.) This is the time when the sun is at its fullest and brightest. Pray that your life would be bright. This is also the time to pray not to be led into any temptation, trap or snare of the enemy.
- ▶ Prayer Decrees for This Watch

**Your light shines through me, and I live so that people will see my good works and give praise to You. (Matthews 5:16)**

# Eight Prayer Watch (3:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M.)

3 p.m. to 6 p.m. – Time to transform history; time to remove veils, coverings of darkness; prayer hour of covenants; the hour of triumphant glory; the time for establishing kingdom

The eighth prayer watch is the hour of dying to self and rejoicing in the power of the Cross. We can receive God's help because of the selfless sacrifice of His Son, Jesus Christ. As Jesus died on the Cross and was resurrected, so the Bible calls us to die to self and live for Christ (Galatians 2:20, NIV).

# Eighth Prayer Watch (3:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M.)

- ▶ **Time to Change or Shape History-** This was the time God changed history because this watch happens to be the time that Jesus died on the Cross (3:00 P.M). Jesus went through six hours of suffering for the deliverance of humankind and the world. Pray for deliverance during this watch. When Jesus died, history was changed forever because He became our Blood Covenant with God and triumphed over hell, death and the grave. After His resurrection, Jesus Christ gave us the power to have the same victory as He did. Rejoice that you have turned your back on sin because you have been cleansed by the Blood of Jesus (1 John 1:7 ).
